The International Wire & Cable Symposium, Inc. (IWCS) is pleased to announce the availability of the Christopher Eoll and the Elmer "Ace" Godwin Memorial Scholarships for interested high school or college students majoring in engineering or science disciplines related to the wire and cable industry.

Normally, the IWCS awards two scholarships annually. This year a second Godwin Scholarship will be awarded. These three scholarships (two Godwin and one Eoll) will be awarded in 2010 valued at \$2,000 each. The scholarship recipients will be notified on or before 30 June 2010. Each scholarship recipient will also be recognized at the IWCS annual conference in November 2010.

International Wire & Cable Symposium 2010 Scholarship Program

Three goals were established for this scholarship program: 1) to promote education in fields of study related to the wire & cable industry; 2) to improve educational opportunities for academically qualified students with financial need and 3) to provide both symbolic and tangible benefits to the industry that sustains the IWCS. Therefore, this scholarship was created to meet these goals.

Christopher Eoll Scholarship: This scholarship was created in honor of an active participant of the IWCS. Dr. Eoll endowed the scholarship to promote interest in the wire and cable industry. The Eoll scholarship is available to either a high school senior or college student.

Elmer “Ace” Godwin Scholarship: This scholarship was created in honor of the long-serving director of the IWCS. The Godwin scholarship is available to either a high school senior or college student.

Availability: The Eoll and Godwin scholarships will be awarded to either a graduating high school senior or a college student

Amount of scholarship: Each scholarship is valued at US\$2,000.

Eligibility: The candidate must be enrolled as a high school senior and planning to enroll in an accredited college or university in the fall of 2010 OR be a college student already enrolled at an accredited college or university. Candidates must be majoring or planning to major in a science or engineering field related to the wire and cable industry.

Scholarship criteria: The committee will evaluate each applicant based on academic achievements as evidenced in high school and/or college, activities in high school and/or college, writing ability and financial need. Past scholarship recipients typically scored 1300 or higher on the SAT (Critical Reading and Mathematics), 29 or above on the ACT and had a 3.7 or higher un-weighted GPA.

Notification- On or before 30 June 2010
