IWCS, Inc Enjoys a Very Successful 2011 Conference

The 60th annual International Cable · Connectivity Symposium drew over 1000 participants to Charlotte, NC in early November. The event featured nearly 100 technical papers, eight Professional Development Courses and approximately 120 exhibit spaces. The Executive Track presented key information from expert industry analysts, as well as views of the future from top industry executives.

Among the highlights of the 2011 event was a 60th Anniversary Party for all attendees in the NASCAR Hall of Fame in Charlotte. Guests were given an opportunity to network with industry friends and to make new acquaintances, plus make use of the NASCAR race simulators. A unique and exciting experience was enjoyed by all.

The IWCS announced that it has contributed nearly \$60k to scholarships and scholarship endowments in 2011. Assisted by a number of industry companies, the commitment to scholarship in support of the future is a central theme of the IWCS. The organization also reported that several papers from students were part of the 2011 program, further enhancing the role of the IWCS in developing industry leaders for tomorrow.
